More notable chefs and restaurateurs than ever are heading to the area, among them **Galen Zamarra of Mas (Farmhouse)**, Frank DeCarlo of Peasant, Philippe Delgrange of Le Bilboquet, James Mallios of Amali and the company run by the celebrity chef Todd English.
