SOUND VIEW GREENPORT & THE HARBORFRONT INN

Sound View Greenport and The Harborfront Inn are waterfront sister hotels located on the North Fork of Long Island in Greenport, NY – a quaint historic town along the North Fork’s 30 miles of farmland, vineyards and beaches.

Sound View and its onsite restaurant The Halyard are situated on a quarter-mile of private beach on the Long Island Sound. The Harborfront Inn is located in the heart of the quaint Village of Greenport, surrounded by marinas, art galleries, shops, and restaurants. Both hotels are newly renovated, have extensive health & safety protocols and are just 5 minutes from each other.



UNCOMMON ART

Sound View Greenport and The Harborfront Inn will once again host the Uncommon Art Residency Program between January and March 2022. This is the fourth year of the program which began at Sound View in 2019 and has since expanded to our sister property [The Anvil Hotel](#) in Jackson Hole, Wyoming.

Uncommon Art is a means for our hotels to continue their dedication to supporting the arts, fostering inspiration and creativity, and sharing with the local community.

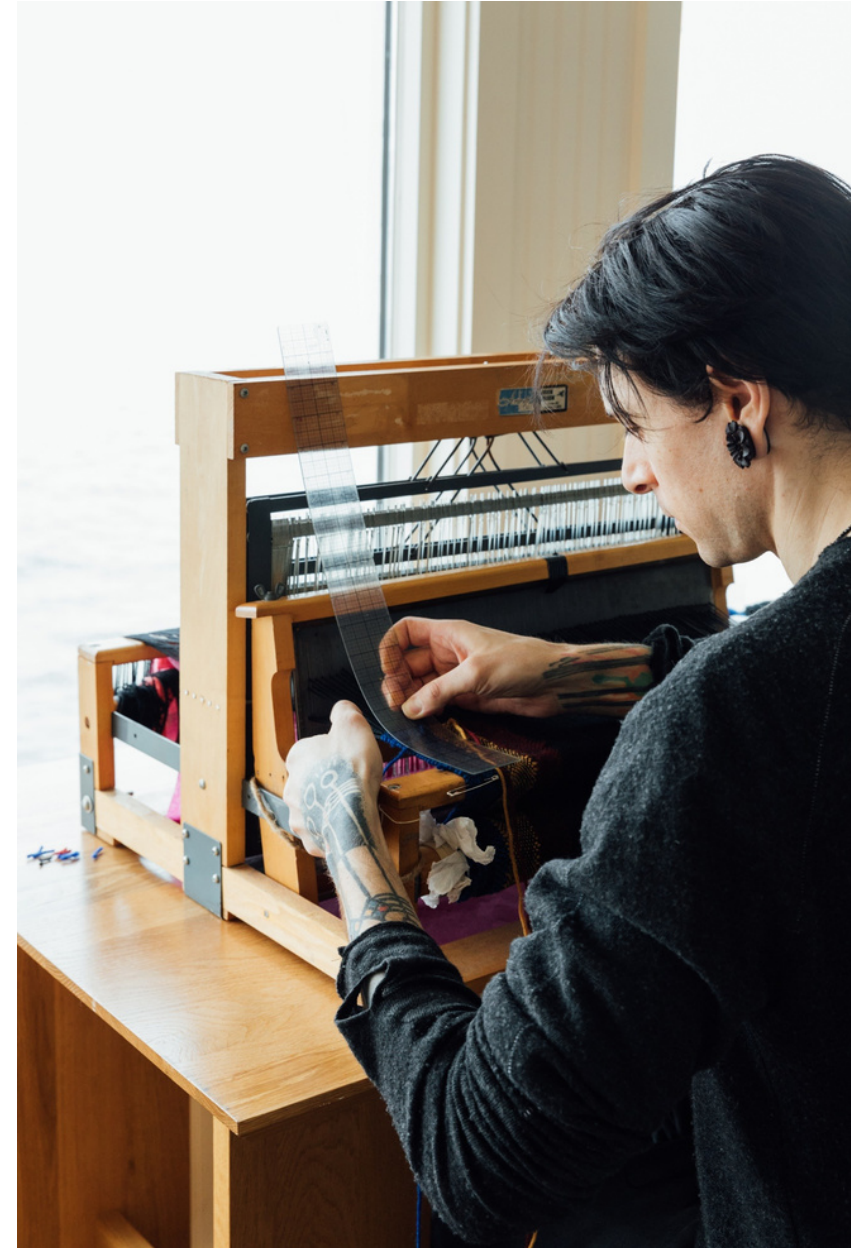

RESIDENCY

GREENPORT, NY

- Artists are invited to work in various spaces across the property during their residency including the restaurant, Piano Bar, lounge, conference and yoga rooms and beach.
- As part of the residency, each artist will have the opportunity to share their work with the community in a socially distanced manner – for musicians this may be a scheduled performance in the Halyard Room and for artists this may be an open working session, a lecture, display, etc.
- Artists will be featured in Sound View and Harborfront’s marketing communications which may include website, email, social media, and press
- At least 1 Instagram post to the artist’s feed and 1 post per day to Stories tagging #uncommonart, #seeyouatsoundview, #uncommonhotels #soundviewgreenport #harborfrontinn @soundviewgreenport @harborfrontinn are also part of the residency
- At the end of the residency, artists will provide a summary of their experience including what inspired them and what they accomplished.



OFFER

- Up to 7-night stay at Sound View Greenport or The Harborfront Inn. January-March 2023 timing dependent on hotel occupancy.
- Up to \$100 transportation reimbursement
- Continental Breakfast each morning
- \$100 dining credit at [The Halyard Restaurant](#). The Halyard is currently open for lunch Friday-Sunday and dinner Thursday-Monday (schedule subject to change).
- Participants will be selected for the residency by the hotels' Ownership, Management teams, & guest curators.
