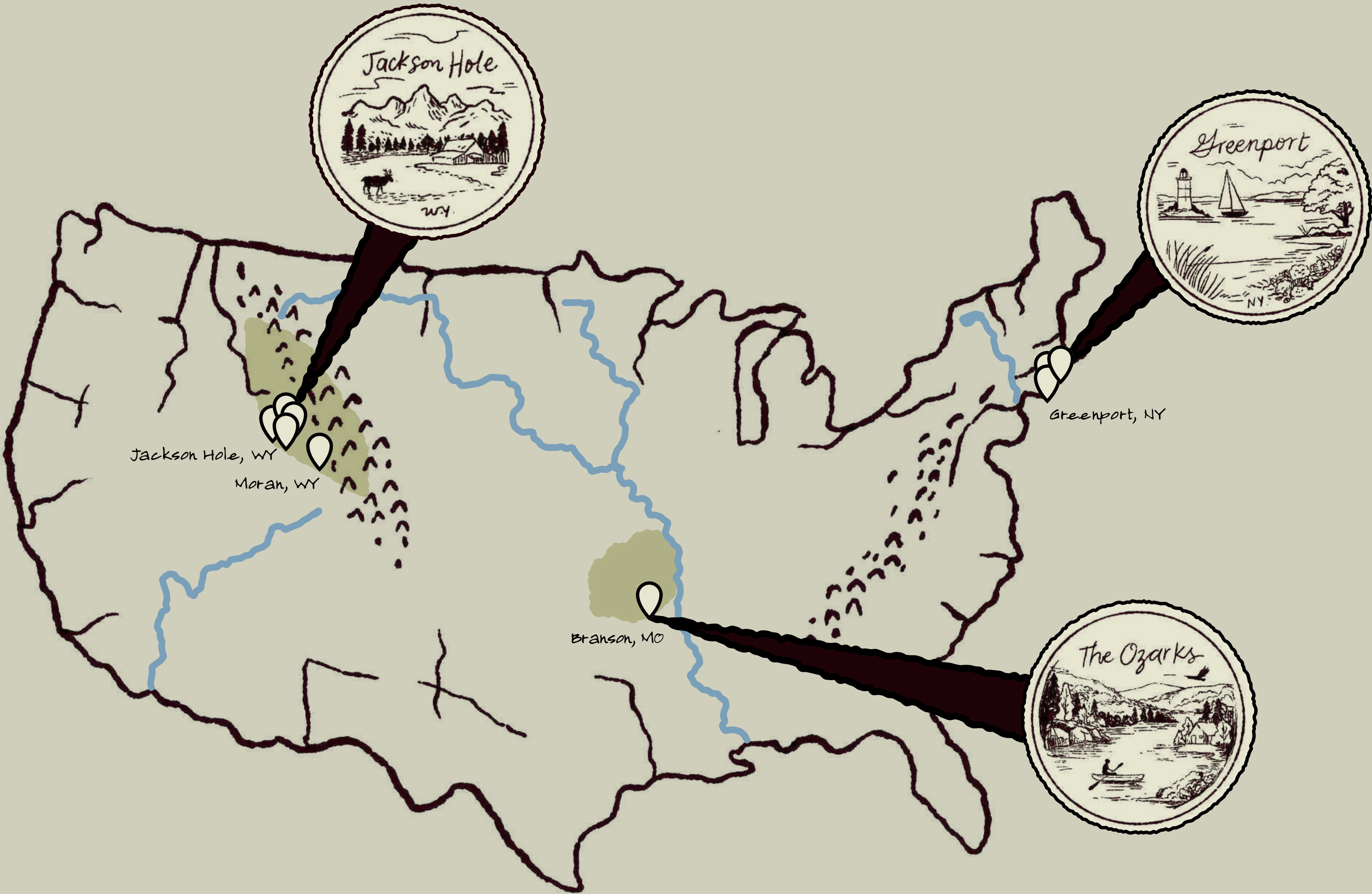

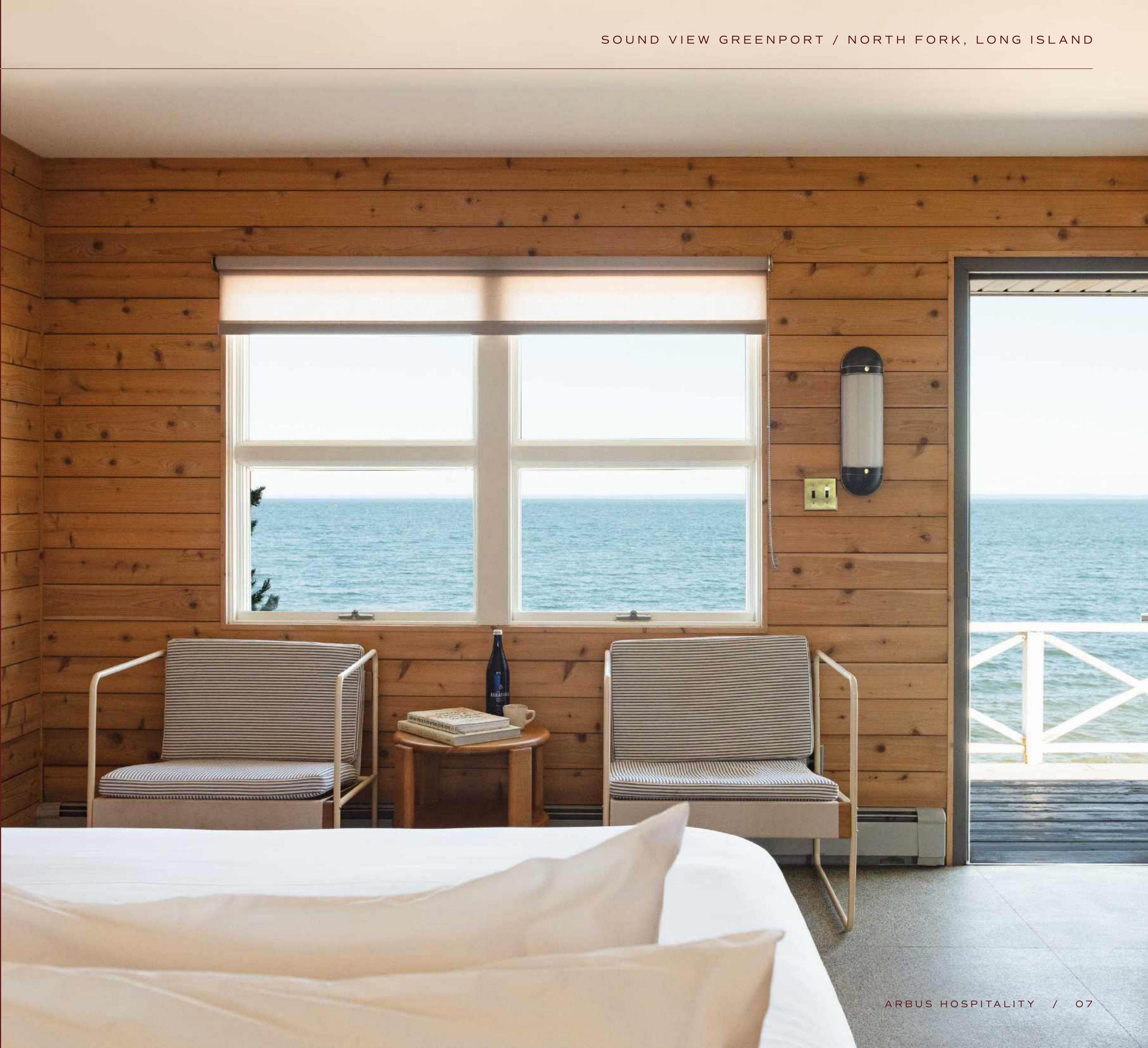

- Classroom Style Seating: 80 guests

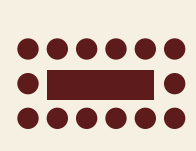




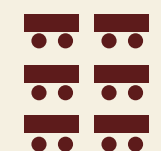

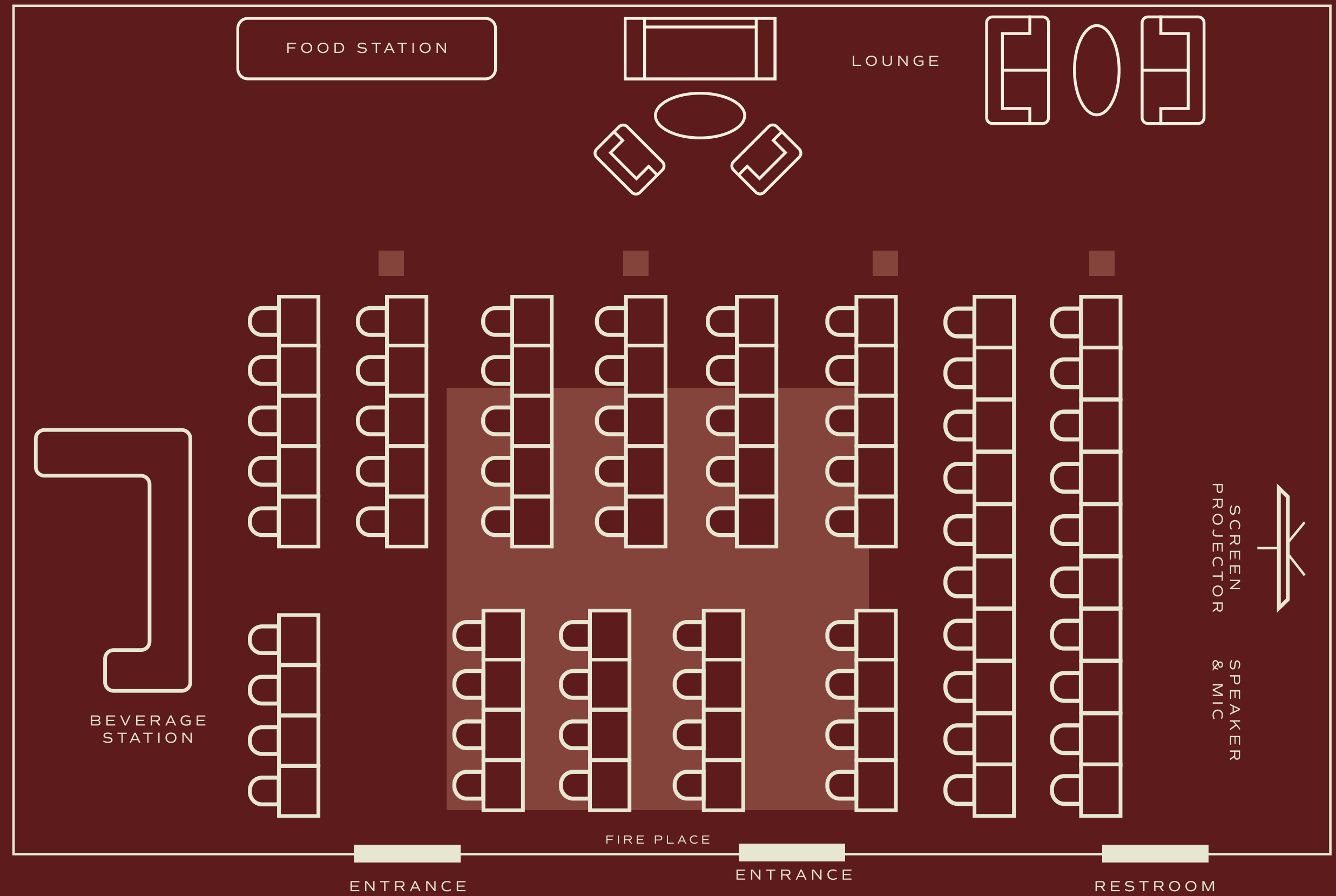

Meeting Setup: Classroom | Capacity: 50 guests

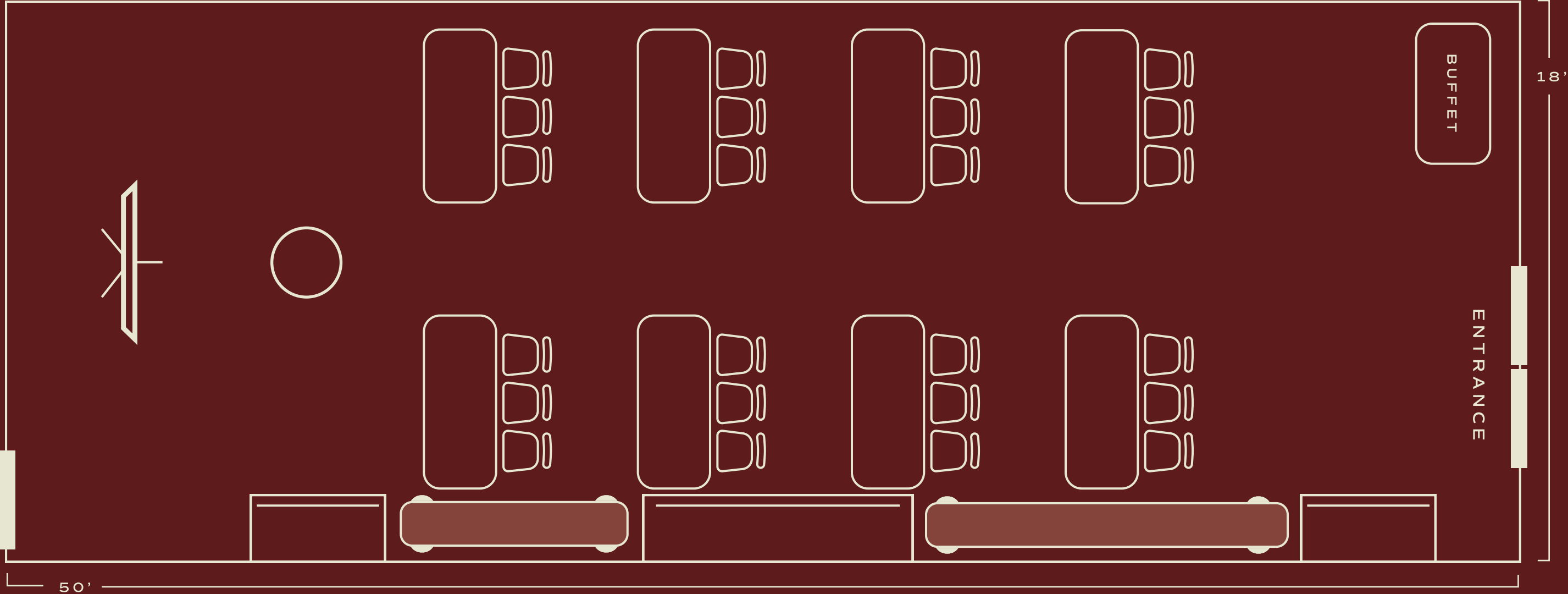
THE LIBRARY

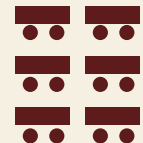

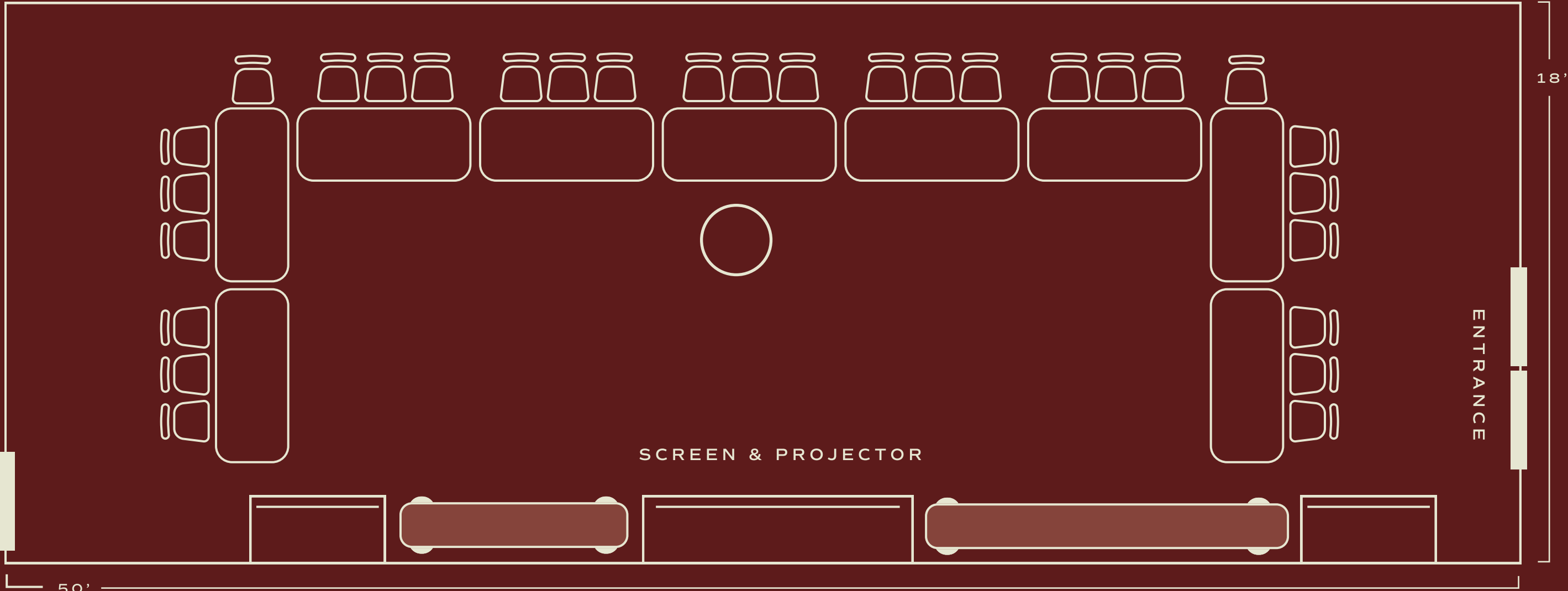

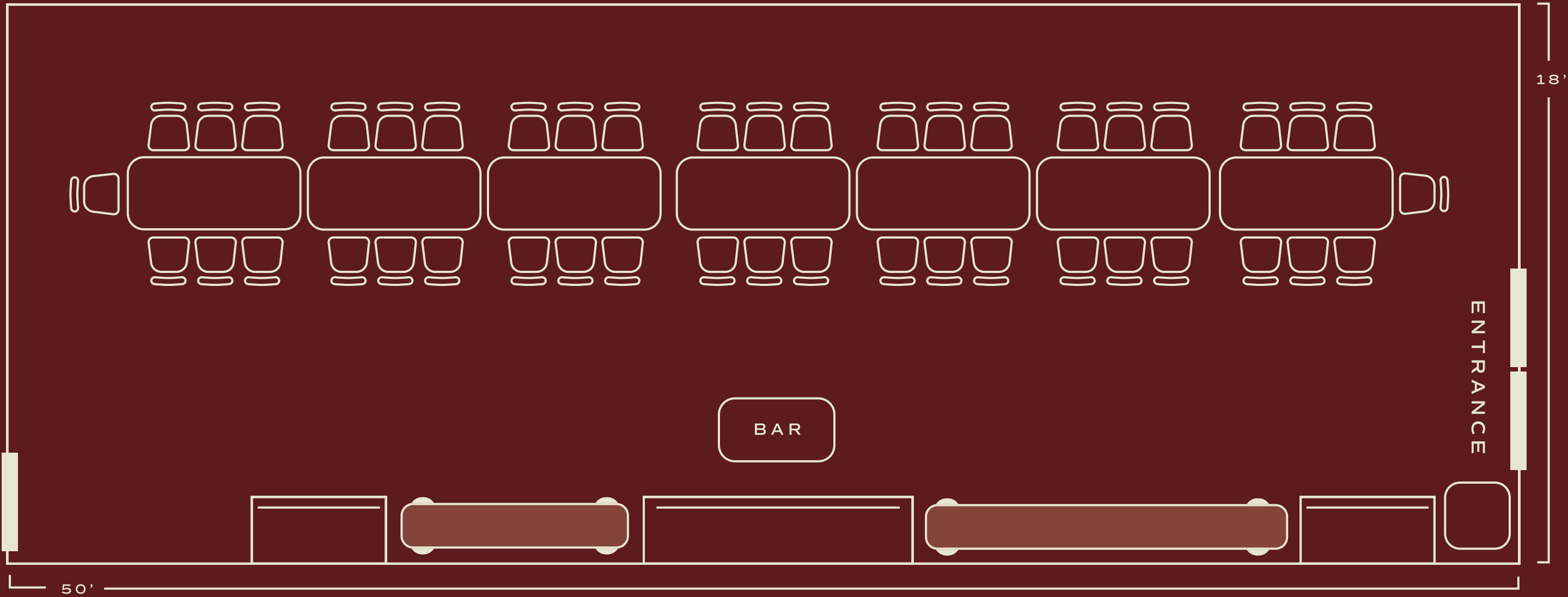
